Park City, Utah (February 2020)

Located across from the resort was a hot spring pool called the "Crater" Those who visited the Crater had an experience not soon forgotten. The Crater is a naturally forming pool from hot springs that maintains 97 degrees year round. The

pool is about 65 feet deep, about 50 feet in diameter, and enclosed with a natural looking dome. The water was so clear that we could see divers practicing deep below us.

The OVSC did a great job of hosting several après ski events, and a farewell reception that included a DJ and line dancing. Several of us got our groove on!

The beauty of the west, great snow, nice resort, fellowship of new and longstanding club members, and the OVSC activities made this a wonderful trip!




2-9-20 to 2-12-20
