News From the Executive VP

LSSC will have 3 trips in 2026. The first trip will be to Park City, Utah from January 17-24. We will be staying in the ski-in, ski-out Snow Flower Condominiums - rated as the #1 condo in Park City on Tripadvisor. You can sign up here: OVSC Park City.

The second trip will be to Andermatt, Switzerland, February 20-28, with an optional extension to Zurich, Switzerland. You can sign up here: <u>Group Travel Simplicity - LSSC Andermatt</u>.

The third LSSC trip will be to Keystone, Colorado, March 14-21. We will be staying in the Saint John Condos, a short shuttle bus ride from the mountain. There will also be optional trips to Vail and to Breckenridge. You can sign up here: LSSC Keystone Trip Registration

All of these resorts accept the Local Epic Pass (the less expensive of the Epic Passes). As in past years, you can receive a rebate on your Epic Pass if you purchase it through the trip vendor (Sportsamerica for the Park City trip; Group Travel Simplicity [GTS] for the Andermatt trip). The LSSC Board is organizing the Keystone trip ourselves, so no rebate is available if Keystone is your only trip. Sportsamerica will offer a Park City trip credit of 6.5% of the revenue of the pass purchased. GTS will offer a \$50 Andermatt trip rebate if you purchase the Epic Pass through their website: https://www.winterskiandsport.com/epicpassesonsale.

Snowshoe, West Virginia

February 1 - 5, 2026 Sunday - Thursday

Trip details:

- *4 Nights Lodging at 5-bedroom, 4-bathroom, 2 level house. Check in Feb 1 after 4pm, leave by 10am on Feb 5
- *3 planned evening dinners prepared at the house and last night of either leftovers or "on your own". Bring your own beverages.
- *Pricing will be determined by the number of participants (8-11), and bed/pillow configuration, ranging from \$371 to \$495; Another lodging option may be considered if there's additional interest when maximum occupancy is reached. This will give an option for a limited number of single supplements, price TBD based on number of participants.
- *Deposit of \$150 due by Nov 1, Remaining balance due by Dec 27, 2025. Pay on the club's website.
- *Must be a 2025-2026 season paid member of Lexington Ski and Snowboard Club or any other OVSC club
- *3 full days of skiing Monday-Wednesday; option to buy a 3-Day Flex Pass on Snowshoe's website for \$199, suggest before Oct 1, 2025. It will no longer be available once the ski season begins or sooner if they sell out.
- *Transportation will be car-pooling when possible. A 4-wheel or all- wheel vehicle is recommended due to the steep driveway at the house. Option of parking at the Top of the World lot 0.5 miles away.
- *House accommodations are full at this time. If anyone is interested, a wait list will be used if there are any cancelations. For more information please contact trip leader Robin Jones: localectivity@lexskisnowboard.org

Andermatt and Zurich, Switzerland

February 20 - March 3, 2026

Join Lexington Ski and Snowboard Club for great Alpine skiing at multiple areas easily accessible from Andermatt, for touring some of the most beautiful country you will ever see, and a chance to visit several close by unique sites. The trip concludes with three optional nights in Zurich.



Our trip will include...

- Airfare round trip from Lexington to Zurich
- Ground transfers between Zurich and Andermatt and return
- Seven nights accommodations in Andermatt at the Hotel Piz Badus
- Full hot and cold breakfast daily
- Seven dinners
- Mountain orientation at the hotel
- Three night hotel accommodations in Zurich at the Hotel Scheuble
- Breakfast daily in Zurich
- Guided tour of Zurich
- Note that lift tickets are not included in the package, but they are usually considerably more reasonable than in the U.S. as well as equipment rental.

Andermatt ski area is on the Epic pass, so if you are going on any of the LSSC trips, you will be able to use the same pass! GTS will offer a \$50 Andermatt trip rebate if you purchase the Epic Pass through their website:

Pricing for this trip will be from \$3251 to \$4360, depending on your method of payment (credit card or electronic bank check), rooming configuration (private or double room), and whether or not you choose to stay in Zurich at the end of the ski week.

Keystone, Colorado

March 14 - 21, 2026

Keystone resort, just under 2 hours from the Denver Airport, is a playground for all ability levels. There are 3,149 acres of skiable terrain, 1 gondola, and 21 lifts. The base elevation is 9180 ft and the highest peak elevation is 12,408 ft. There is plenty to do for non-skiers or for those wanting to take a day off. The "My Epic" app will help with navigating around the resort and information.

Saint John Condos: Set in North Keystone, it is the ideal choice for quiet relaxation and convenient access to the slopes - just a quick drive or short ride on the free Keystone Resort shuttle to both River Run and Mountain House base areas. Each condo has an open-concept living area, large windows looking out to forest and mountain views, and a fully equipped kitchen. Building amenities include ski storage lockers, indoor hot tub, and the convenience of 3 shared sets of washer and dryers. Parking is inside the building's covered area. Transportation will be rental SUV's.

Roommate arrangements and single supplement: If you are signing up solo, please try to list a roommate on the trip application or notify the trip leader of any preference when arranged. If you do not have someone in mind, we will assist with matching up roommates, being mindful of balancing the male and female beds. For those who prefer to add a single supplement option, if available, will be determined on the different layouts in each condo.

If registration is full before you sign up, please request to be added to the waitlist and we'll notify you if a space becomes available. Lodging and transportation cost is subject to change based on final number of participates and if any additional condo space and vehicle is needed. It may be possible to add a condo at a different location other than Saint John to accommodate those on the waitlist.


