- *4 Nights Lodging at 5-bedroom, 4-bathroom, 2-level house; Check-in Feb 1 after 4pm, leave by 10am on Feb 5

Park City, Utah



Ten LSSC skiers flew out to Utah on Saturday, January 17 for a week's skiing at Park City. We were joined by 10 skiers from the Dayton Ski Club. After landing in Salt Lake City, all 20 of us took a bus to our condos in Park City, with a grocery stop at Smiths in Park City. We got to our ski-in, ski-out condos, in the late afternoon.



Park City consists of two former separate areas, Park City Mountain and The Canyons, which are now connected by a gondola. On Sunday, we had a bluebird day with temps in the upper 30's—actually our weather for the entire week! The group skied the Park City side on Sunday. That night, both clubs went to a “Welcome Reception” at Flanigan’s Irish Pub on Main Street, managing to get tables for all 20 of our group.

Monday proved to be an exciting day when most of us went over to the Canyons. On the way to the main ski area, one of the group had problems on a steeper-than-expected Blue run and ended up “derriere-sliding” down most of the slope—without skis. A second skier took off their skis to help, lost their balance, and tumbled down to the bottom. A third member pulled a muscle while cross country skiing at the Park City Nordic Center, and had to rest for the rest of the week. Happily, the remainder of the trip was relatively uneventful! That night, several of us went downtown to watch the College Football Championship game.





Most of the group went over to the Canyons again on Tuesday. That night, we went to the Italian restaurant, Versante Hearth and Bar, a TripAdvisor Travelers Choice. On Wednesday, it was back to the Park City side. That night we went to a Mexican place on Main Street, Tekila Mexican Grill & Cantina. On Thursday, the group split up with some skiing Canyons and others Park City. That night there was a pizza party for both the Lexington and Dayton groups at a conference room in the condo complex.



As the week went along, we heard reports of a major winter storm due to hit Lexington and Dayton. By Wednesday, it became apparent that we might not be able to get back to Lexington on Saturday. On Thursday, Sportsamerica offered us flights to fly back early. On Friday, we bused down to Salt Lake City, and flew back to Lexington. It was disappointing to lose a day of skiing, but everyone was happy to be back in Lexington before the storm hit. As it turned out, our original flight back to Lexington on Saturday was canceled.

Andermatt and Zurich, Switzerland

February 20 – March 3, 2026

Join Lexington Ski and Snowboard Club for great Alpine skiing at multiple areas easily accessible from Andermatt, for touring some of the most beautiful country you will ever see, and a chance to visit several close by unique sites. The trip concludes with three optional nights in Zurich.



Our trip will include...

- Airfare round trip from Lexington to Zurich
- Ground transfers between Zurich and Andermatt and return
- Seven nights accommodations in Andermatt at the Hotel Piz Badus
- Full hot and cold breakfast daily
- Seven dinners
- Mountain orientation at the hotel
- Three night hotel accommodations in Zurich at the Hotel Scheuble
- Breakfast daily in Zurich
- Guided tour of Zurich
- Note that lift tickets are not included in the package, but they are usually considerably more reasonable than in the U.S. as well as equipment rental.

Andermatt ski area is on the Epic pass, so if you are going on any of the LSSC trips, you will be able to use the same pass! GTS will offer a \$50 Andermatt trip rebate if you purchase the Epic Pass through their website:

Pricing for this trip will be from \$3251 to \$4360, depending on your method of payment (credit card or electronic bank check), rooming configuration (private or double room), and whether or not you choose to stay in Zurich at the end of the ski week.

Keystone, Colorado

March 14 - 21, 2026

Keystone resort, just under 2 hours from the Denver Airport, is a playground for all ability levels. There are 3,149 acres of skiable terrain, 1 gondola, and 21 lifts. The base elevation is 9180 ft and the highest peak elevation is 12,408 ft. There is plenty to do for non-skiers or for those wanting to take a day off. The “My Epic” app will help with navigating around the resort and information.

Saint John Condos : Set in North Keystone, it is the ideal choice for quiet relaxation and convenient access to the slopes - just a quick drive or short ride on the free Keystone Resort shuttle to both River Run and Mountain House base areas. Each condo has an open-concept living area, large windows looking out to forest and mountain views, and a fully equipped kitchen. Building amenities include ski storage lockers, indoor hot tub, and the convenience of 3 shared sets of washer and dryers. Parking is inside the building’s covered area. Transportation will be rental SUV’s.

Roommate arrangements and single supplement : If you are signing up solo, please try to list a roommate on the trip application or notify the trip leader of any preference when arranged. If you do not have someone in mind, we will assist with matching up roommates, being mindful of balancing the male and female beds. For those who prefer to add a single supplement option, if available, will be determined on the different layouts in each condo.

If registration is full before you sign up, please request to be added to the waitlist and we’ll notify you if a space becomes available. Lodging and transportation cost is subject to change based on final number of participants and if any additional condo space and vehicle is needed. It may be possible to add a condo at a different location other than Saint John to accommodate those on the waitlist.

- Convenient payments on the club website

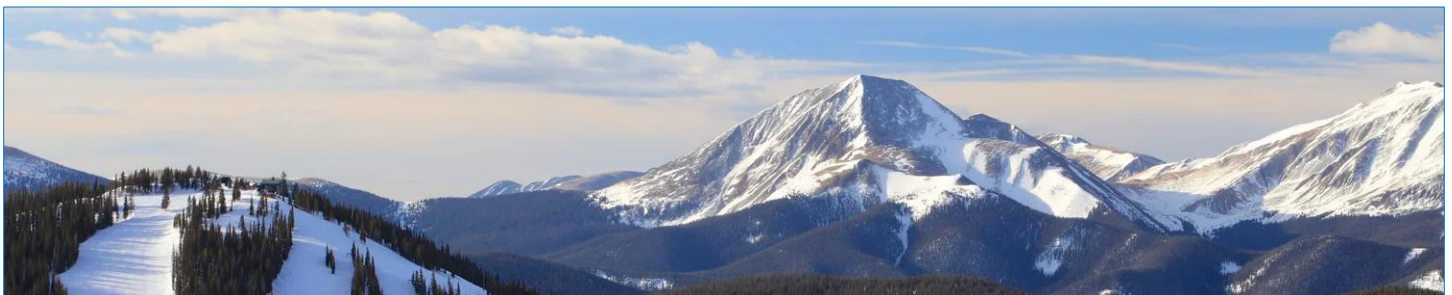
