Snowshoe is an “Island in the sky”, with the resort located at the top of the mountain! Lodging

NYE: Silver Creek Lodge

This lodge is just steps from the Silver Creek ski area, which provides great trails, and night skiing. Lodge amenities include an indoor/outdoor swimming pool, indoor/outdoor hot tubs, sauna, fitness room, dining options, stores and a ski/snowboard rental shop.



Feb 9 Trip: Rimfire Lodge

In the heart of the Village at Snowshoe, these units give you access to all the shops & restaurants as well as Ballhooter Lift and the basin ski area. Lift Tickets



Lift tickets are not being offered by the club, because they can be purchased at a **SIGNIFICANT discount** in advance directly from Snowshoe. The best value is buying a three (or four) day advance lift ticket.

Advance tickets are sold on a “tiered” basis, meaning when the current tier of tickets are sold, the next tier is offered at an increased price. Advance tickets must be purchased at least 72 hours in advance, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and are valid for only the date(s) purchased!

Lift tickets rates for: **Dec 30 – Jan 1** (as of 9/12/19):

3-day Advance: \$172 (plus tax).

3-day Walk-up: \$285.60 (plus tax). Single-day Walk-up: \$119 (plus tax).

Lift ticket rates for: **Feb 10 – 12** (as of 9/12/19):

3 day Advance: \$114 (plus tax).

3-day walk-up: \$189.60 (plus tax). Single-day walk-up: \$79 (plus tax)

How do I Register to Race for the LSSC?

To race under the LSSC flag, you must be a current LSSC member. If you are NOT a 2018/19 member, go to <https://www.lexskisports.org/membership> to pay your dues (\$40 via PayPal) and then complete your online application.

To race, you must have a NASTAR ID. Follow the instructions below under Register for a NASTAR ID to obtain your ID as well as the instructions under Finalize the Process to Race. If you already have a NASTAR ID and want to race with the LSSC, 1) login to Nostar.com, 2) make sure your PERSONAL settings are as listed below in red, and 3) follow the instructions below under Finalize the Process to Race.

Register for a NASTAR ID

To obtain a NASTAR ID, follow the instructions below.

1. Go to www.nastar.com.
2. Click on **REGISTER** in the title bar.
3. Fill-in all of the fields through **Birthdate**. For **Racer Discipline**, pick the appropriate discipline. Most people will select either **Alpine Skier** or **Snowboard**.
4. Under the heading of **Create or Join a Team**, make the following selections:
 - a. **Family/Friends Team** = **Perfect North Slopes** (not any of the other Perfect North sections)
 - b. **Club Team** = **Lexington Ski Club**
 - c. **Resort Team** = **Ohio Valley Ski Council**
5. In the **Your Password** section, create a password.
6. In the **Special Offers** section, check the boxes if you wish to receive the offers.
7. You must then click the **I agree to the above release** box.
8. Click on the last box if you are agreeing to the release for a minor participant.
9. Fill in the **missing medal** to show you are not a robot and then click the **register** button.

You will then receive a Thank You screen confirming you have successfully registered for NASTAR. The message includes your NASTAR Registration Number (NASTAR ID) and Password. It also includes confirmation you will receive a FREE one-year subscription to SKI Magazine.


To race for the LSSC, you must contact Racing Chair, Dianna (Lady Di) Miller (see contact info below) and:
