TRIP LEADERS NEEDED!

Trip leaders are needed for Telluride and Jackson Hole. An application form is included on the next page. Trip leaders may receive total or partial compensation of their trip costs. Trip leader duties include the following:

- Planning and coordinating trip transportation, room arrangements, activities and trip payments.
- Collecting all trip payments.
- Verifying that all participants are members.
- Supervising transportation to and from the resort. Trip leaders are expected to use the club flights.
- Coordinate group activities at the resort, such as organizing a meeting place for lunch.
- Submit a final accounting for all trip receipts, expenses and administrative costs after the conclusion of the trip.

Epic Pass

You can buy a discounted Epic Pass if you are going on the LSSC trip to Telluride. This includes the Local, Full and 5, 6 & 7-Day Passes. However, the Epic Local Pass does not include Telluride, so don't purchase this version. The discount is in the form of a lodging rebate. 
Ikon Pass

You can buy a discounted Ikon Pass if you are going on the LSSC trip to Jackson Hole. This includes the full Ikon Pass, the Ikon Base Pass, and the Ikon Base PLUS Pass. The Ikon Base Pass does not include Jackson Hole, however, so don't purchase this version. The discount is in the form of a lodging credit. 
