



OVSC Summer in Europe: Croatia and Istanbul, September 2014

Dayton Ski Club is offering a trip to Croatia in early September with an optional extension to Istanbul. A few spaces are available to other OVSC members. Pricing is around \$3195 for Croatia, and includes round trip air to Zagreb and return from Dubrovnik, most meals, all touring as listed, fuel surcharge, departure taxes, and local tax. Istanbul is around \$1195 and includes airfare from Istanbul to Zagreb, 4 nights accommodation at a four-star hotel, breakfast daily, touring each day as outlined in itinerary, airport transfers, and local taxes.
